On a one-time basis due solely to Covid 19, the International has relaxed the requirements for absentee ballots to include Covid-19 related requests.

"The request for an absentee ballot must be made in writing to the Chair Person of the election committee, and must be received by the Chair Person of the election committee seven (7) or more days in advance of the date of the Local Union election. Requests for absentee ballots which are received six (6) or fewer days in advance of the election should not be honored." The request must indicate the reason that will prevent the member from appearing at the polls. You must include your phone number to schedule a pick-up date.
